No refunds will be made for admission or class cancellation after the show has started. A negative Coggins Test is required for all horses on show grounds. Any horse turned down by DQP will forfeit entry fee. DQP decisions are final. Persons in federal disqualification cannot transport horses to this show and can participate only as a spectator.
